


The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) USDA Annual Eligibility Form 2023

I am eligible to receive TEFAP commodity food because:

- I am in Minnesota (my physical presence in MN confirms my eligibility)
- My household income is 300% or less of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (see table below)
- I am also eligible if I receive or participate in any of the following programs:
 - MFIP (Minnesota Family Investment Program)
 - Child Care Assistance, GA (General Assistance)
 - SNAP (Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program)
 - NAPS (Nutritional Assistance Program for Seniors)
 - WIC (Women, Infants, and Children)
 - Head Start
 - Section 8
 - Public Housing
 - Energy Assistance
 - Weatherization
